We will be following the Phonics, Writing and Reading CLUSP (Trust) programmes, and using Maths Mastery to compliment our sessions. We will utilise the CUSP Science, Geography and History units, but will run a thematic approach to these, mixing them to create more of a topic-based learning.

In our Science lessons in October, we will have a visit from the local dental nurse, which is very exciting. She has lots of activities planned, so look out for more about that nearer the time. After half-term, we will visit the local church to investigate the idea of belonging and belief in RE.
