Dear families,

Our staff will be on hand to support if children need guiding in the right direction. Class teachers will also meet and greet children on the playground so that they know where to go.
- Teachers will aim to start the school day promptly if you need to communicate with your child's new class teacher please do so via Class Dojo or the admin email.

Developing these routines will then allow us to hit the ground running in September, with children being able to walk themselves straight into class once the gates open. Thank you for your support with this.

Mr Hunter has been with us for six years at Place Farm and has played a huge role in maintaining our site to a high standard. Celebration Assembly


Congratulations to everyone who received a certificate in celebration assembly this week. We had lots of children receiving their coloured certificates today. We also had children receiving their PROUD certificates.






We also had several pupils celebrated for their achievements outside of school.
