#### Instructions for parents/carers for Holiday, Activities and Food programme bookings.

The Winter activities for Suffolk Holiday, Activities and Food programme (HAF) will be live for booking on Eequ on the 20th of November 2024



Please register children and book activities for the Winter School holidays at: WWW.eequ.org

- Parents/carers can use the link provided to log into Eequ and register their child(ren) and book them on to the activities of their choice.
- Eligibility checks will be completed at this stage and if the child meets the criteria, they will receive an email confirming the booking, please provide information on the child's eligibility and receipt of benefit related Free School Meals in the booking so that eligible bookings are not rejected.
- If they are accepted an email will be sent to the email address confirming the booking. Bookings without an email confirming the eligibility and place are not confirmed. Please ensure that you receive the email to confirm bookings.
- If the booking is rejected due to not meeting the criteria or not providing required evidence, an email will go to the booking email address explaining why. This can be appealed if further information or evidence can be provided. (This will require re booking of the activity.) You can email Suffolk HAF at <a href="https://haFenquiries@suffolk.gov.uk">HAFenquiries@suffolk.gov.uk</a>

Bookings are subject to availability and eligibility and cannot be guaranteed, we recommend booking early to avoid disappointment.

HAF eligibility is based on the child(ren) being in receipt of Benefit Related Free School Meals. As per the Easter and Summer School Holidays, Suffolk HAF programme will no longer be issuing codes to families in receipt of benefit related Free School Meals and will be continuing to use the Eequ Booking system for parents/carers to book children onto the activities.

#### Important information regarding Household Support Fund discretionary grant

Suffolk County Council (SCC) is pleased to confirm that the Government announced a further six-month extension to the Household Support Fund from September 2024 to March 2025.

We can confirm that funds have been made available for SCC to extend the support previously provided to low-come families in receipt of Free school Meals (FSM) over the **Christmas Holidays 2024**. There is currently no information on whether funding will be available after this date.

The grant will be issued as a £30 supermarket voucher for each eligible child from our provider Pluxee and is designed to help families with their essential living costs during the holiday.

As with previous issues of vouchers, the SCC Free School Meals (FSM) team will place the voucher order using the information provided by your child's school. Please ensure that your child's school holds the most up to date contact information for you, so that the voucher is sent to the correct recipient.

If the school has previously printed the vouchers on your behalf, then this arrangement will continue, or you can ask for the voucher to be sent via text message to your mobile phone number. Please inform your school if you wish to receive the vouchers via text message, if you have previously been unable to receive them via email.

We aim to have all vouchers sent to recipients by Wednesday 11 December 2024. If you have not received the vouchers by this date or in the event of any queries regarding the vouchers, then please contact our team at <a href="mailto:freeschoolmeals@suffolk.gov.uk">freeschoolmeals@suffolk.gov.uk</a>, rather than speaking to the school directly.

Please note, that if you have children who attend different Suffolk schools, you may receive your vouchers at separate times before the start of the school holiday.

Please look out for an email from <a href="mailto:noresponse@vouchers.sodexoengage.com">noresponse@vouchers.sodexoengage.com</a>, and please also check junk and spam folders before contacting us directly.

Please can we remind you that all vouchers will have a 2-month expiry date to be redeemed. Once redeemed, the expiry conditions of your chosen supermarket will apply, and you will have a minimum of 12 months to use the voucher. We urge you to contact our team as soon as possible if you encounter any issues redeeming your voucher as we will not be able to access the funding once it has closed and vouchers have expired.

We hope that this discretionary grant goes some way to help in supporting your family during the school holiday, whether buying food or freeing up some income to go towards energy and water bills or other essential living costs.
